



TOLEDO SCHOOL DISTRICT WINTER SNOW ROUTES

- During inclement weather, buses may be running a few minutes late depending on the road conditions.
- The local radio stations as well as TV stations will broadcast any change in our school/transportation scheduling. You may also contact the District hotline at 864-4636 regarding school closure or late start.
- If it is announced that school are starting one or two hours late, please remember that bus routes will also be one or two hours later than normal.
- Pick-up times and locations will be on their regular schedules unless **WINTER SNOW ROUTES** are announced. Only when it is announced that buses are running on **WINTER SNOW ROUTES**, the following route changes will be in effect for **ALL** the (A.M. and P.M. routes).

§ **Route #1** – No changes

§ **Route #2** – Smokey Valley, Lone Yew and Blake roads will be driven backwards make sure students are out 5 minutes earlier than normal times.

§ **Route #3** – No changes

§ **Route #4** – No changes

§ **Route #5** – All students on Hinkley Rd., Evans Rd., and Grimmes Rd. will meet @ Evans Rd. & Hurst Rd. about 7:25 AM.

§ **Route #6** – No Maw Rd. students will meet the bus @ Hwy 505 & Maw Rd 7:30 AM.

§ **Route #7** – No changes

§ **Route #9** – No Comas Rd. off Winlock Vader Rd or Winlock Vadewr Rd. students will meet bus @ Store on Hwy 506 & Winlock Vader Rd.

§ **Route #10** – No S. Military Rd.-students meet bus @ Old Vader School site 7:35 AM.

§ **Route #11** – No West end of Howe Rd. past Sorenson's Dairy meet @ Spencer Rd and Howe Rd @ Approx. 7:25 AM. No Rakoz Rd.-students meet bus @ Jackson Hwy. & Rakoz Rd. @ 7:50 AM



WINTER SAFETY HINTS FOR BUS STUDENTS:

- Make sure your students are dressed APPROPRIATELY for the weather, including clothing that can be seen in the dark. Delays may occur due to road conditions.
- Talk with your student about where to wait for the bus. Make sure that they stand back away from the roadway approximately 10 feet. Do not allow students to stand behind any objects where drivers cannot see them or stand near large puddles of water.
- If your student is late for the bus, make sure he/she does not run for the bus. Students may slip and fall into the roadway where vehicles cannot stop quickly. During slick winter road conditions, buses need extra room to stop.
